- PRE-SANDY, WHAT DID THE LBI PANCAKE HOUSE MEAN TO THE COMMUNITY?
- A The Pancake House had become a tradition to so many families. The island's homeowners were constantly coming in to share stories about their lives. Also, we supported the police department, lifeguards and EMTs with discounts.

- ☑ WHAT ROLE DOES THE FIRE DEPARTMENT PLAY IN THE COMMUNITY?
- A We protect property from fire, assist with motor vehicle accidents and water rescue, and conduct fire prevention classes every year for schools. During the storm, we assisted in evacuations and we received a lot of food and supplies, so if anyone needed anything, they could come by. Also, we went to every house and checked the gas mains for leaks. And once electricity was restored, we went back out to every house to make sure nothing caught on fire.
- HOW DID THE STORM AFFECT YOUR
 BUILDING?
- A Our entire first floor had 42 inches of water, and our upstairs meeting room was completely trashed.
- WHAT WILL IT MEAN TO HAVE A FULLY FUNCTIONING BUILDING AGAIN?
- A That the company is fully operational again is huge.
 The kitchen is one of our main sources of revenue. It helps us fund all of our firefighting equipment.
- HOW WAS THE EXPERIENCE OF WORKING WITH CHEF ROBERT IRVINE AND THE TEAM?
- A Working with Chef Irvine was a blast! He is one of us without a doubt. He's a true hero for all that he does for different charities and the armed services. As far as the crew, one word: AMAZING! It was such an honor to be able to work with them.

RECIPE FROM A LEXUS CULINARY MASTER

SHAVED BRUSSELS SPROUT SALAD

With Fried Marcona Almonds, Sieved Egg, Pecorino and Whole-Citrus Vinaigrette

INGREDIENTS

- 1 dozen large eggs, hard cooked (see cook's note below)
- 6 dozen (8 to 9 cups) Brussels sprouts
- 3 dozen (¾ cup) Marcona
 - 1/4 cup grated Pecorino-
- 1 teaspoon sea salt, preferably gray salt

½ navel orange, or 1 small orange

½ teaspoon freshly ground pepper

Whole-Citrus Vinaigrette:

2 lemons, preferably Meyer

shallot

1½ cups olive oil

DIRECTIONS

For the vinaigrette: Use a juice extractor to juice the lemons, orange and shallot, using the entire fruit with peel. Pour the juices into a small bowl, and gradually whisk in the olive oil in a thin stream to form an emulsion. Season with the salt and pepper. Taste and adjust the seasoning. Whisk again, cover and refrigerate for at least 30 minutes or up to 3 days. You should have about 2 cups.

To sieve the eggs: At Bottega, we push the hard-cooked egg whites through the sieve separately, then sieve the yolks and layer the two separately when serving. If it's easier, you can sieve the whole eggs and not bother separating whites from yolks.

Using a mandoline, carefully shave each Brussels sprout holding the stem end. You should have about 9 cups when they're all grated. In a large bowl, toss together the shaved Brussels sprouts, sieved eggs and chopped almonds. Pour on about ³/₄ cup of the vinaigrette and toss again. Spoon into small chilled bowls, and top with the Pecorino. Top with a little more of the vinaigrette.

Summer Variation: Substitute 9 cups of julienned sugar snap peas for the shaved Brussels sprouts.

Cook's Note: If you don't have a sieve for the egg, don't go out and buy one: improvise! My mom was a master at using one tool for another job; for this, you can use a box grater, a slotted spoon, a colander or anything with holes that you can push an egg through.
